EDUCATION IS A BRIDGE

TO OPPORTUNITY, A LIGHT IN DARKNESS, AND A WEAPON AGAINST POVERTY.

We believe education is a transformative tool that breaks the cycles of poverty, empowers children to shape their future. This year, we've empowered over **500 children and youth** through our educational initiatives including sponsorship, book clubs, library initiatives, and personalized tutoring sessions.

Thanks to our generous sponsors, **23 students** received full scholarships covering tuition, scholastic supplies, personal materials like shoes and backpacks, one-on-one counseling and mentorship, and additional learning resources. This year we also introduced book clubs in two partner primary schools lacking pre-existing resources to improve literacy and comprehension, critical thinking, and a love for reading through sessions and activities like group reading, spelling bees, debate, and dictionary training.

We supported **117 primary seven students** from five schools as they prepared to take their national examinations - providing them with mathematical sets and success cards, and praying with them to encourage them in God's sovereignty and plans for their lives.

We remain committed to ensure education is accessible to the most vulnerable children, and we extend our deepest gratitude to the many sponsors and supporters who help build brighter futures for these children. Together we are transforming lives and creating hope for generations to come.



BUILDING FAITH AND COMMUNITY

SOL LADIES

Our women's group meets once a month as a cornerstone for spiritual growth and fellowship. Women in the community have gathered together to create a safe and supportive space to share vulnerabilities, to encourage one another, and to reflect on Scriptural truth together.

These meeting encourage women as they openly share their life challenges and uplift one another through prayer and practical advice; they develop meaningful connections where friendship and community flourish; and they support one another in their journeys together as mothers, wives, sisters, and above all: daughters of Christ.



NURTURING GOD-GIVEN GIFTS SOL CLUB

Every weekend our SOL Clubs come alive with laughter, learning, and discovery as children and youth gather to grow in faith and develop their God-given talents through play, skills-based learning, and community.

These gatherings have given us a frontrow seat to witness the incredible gifts that God has placed in each child.

Through the clubs, we have seen talented dancers, singers, and young speakers. Many have shown spiritual maturity leading prayers and encouraging their peers in the Word of God while others show their dedication, skill, hard work, and teamwork through sports.

We see these gifts as an opportunity not only for personal growth and achievement, but for Kingdom impact. Our prayer is to nurture and ground these talents, ensuring they are used to serve God's purposes and craft brighter futures for each of these children and youth.

We are committed to walking alongside these children providing mentorship and opportunities to refine their skills so they can shine their light in their communities, in their families, and beyond.

SOL YOUTH

EPHESIANS 2:10

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

This year we inspired over 200 youth with the theme Created for a Purpose.

We engaged youth across four different regions in a powerful series of events, grounding and challenging them in the truth: they are created for a purpose.

Each of these gatherings aimed to remind young people that they are created for a purpose and that their lives should reflect Christ to their communities through their unique gifts and talents.

Through interactive discussions, personal testimonies, and community-building activities, we emphasized that true purpose is found in Jesus, encouraging them to make God-honoring decisions and use their abilities to impact the people around them positively.

DISABILITY IS NOT A CURSE OR PUNISHMENT FOR PAST MISTAKES



As is sometimes perceived in our communities.

Instead, disability requires an understanding, compassion, support, and advocacy. This shift in perspective is instrumental in breaking down long-standing stigmas and misconceptions, ultimately paving the way for children with disabilities to be seen as valuable members of society and given the resources and support needed to thrive.



Through our special needs inclusion program, we were able to engage the community in meaningful conversations about inclusion and the importance of creating an environment where all children can thrive regardless of their ability. Through our community training initiatives, families and caregivers were equipped with practical skills on how to support their children with special needs to live fulfilling lives.



Better yet, the community's understanding shifted to begin viewing the inherent worth of children with disabilities and is now more committed to giving them the opportunity to grow, learn, and contribute meaningfully to their communities. This marks a crucial milestone in our mission to build a more inclusive and supportive community that reflects the love and compassion of Christ.



A SHADE OF REFUGE, A LIGHT OF CHRIST

Our community center has become a hub of hope and a sanctuary in the community. It stands as one-of-a-kind in the area: providing a safe, nurturing, and welcoming environment where people, young and old, can gather, grow, and thrive.

Every weekend we welcome over 100+ children and youth who come to participate in a variety of enriching activities including: Bible studies, where they are grounded in faith and learn lifechanging lessons from God's Word; Music, dance, and drama, where children and youth are encouraged to express their creativity and discover their talents; Sports and extracurricular games that hone focus and encourage teamwork; and practical skills that provide young people with tools for independence and personal growth.

The pavilion has been a game-changer for our programs. This structure has enabled us to accommodate more children and youth while ensuring they are protected from the elements, such as rain and harsh sun. With this space, our ability to serve has expanded, allowing us to maintain a consistent and comfortable environment for all activities.

The center is not just a building or space, it is a symbol of God's love and provision. It stands as a reminder that every child deserves a place to belong, learn, and grow. As we reflect on the year, we are so grateful for the community's support and God's faithfulness and provision in providing this vital space to the community we serve. Together, we are transforming lives and shaping a brighter future for generations to come.





When we first met Jaja Elias her life looked like a storm with no calm in sight - living in a dilapidated mud and grass-thatched house that barely sheltered her from the elements, she struggled to care for her two grandchildren. The children had never set foot in a school and their days were marked by hunger and despair. Overwhelmed by the weight of her circumstances, Jaja Elias had turned to alcohol as an escape, trying to drown out the sorrow of her struggles.

Through your generosity, a new chapter began for Jaja Elias and her family. Our intervention started with small but impactful steps: engaging her in friendship, enrolling her grandchildren in a local school, ensuring they received wholesome meals, and constructing a modest but sturdy house to replace their crumbling shelter.

The transformation didn't stop there. Jaja Elias was welcomed into our women's group where she not only found support, but also a sense of belonging. Surrounded by other women who understood her pain and shared her journey, she began to rebuild her life. The group became her community: she was no longer alone.

Today, Jaja Elias is supported to ensure she and her family meet their basic physical needs like daily sustenance; she receives guidance and counsel along with other caregivers and families in our sponsorship program; her grandchildren now thrive in school, brimming with potential and a hope for a better future; and she is encouraged in love and faith by a community who cares for her and the wellbeing of her and her grandchildren.

Jaja Elias' story is a powerful reminder of what can happen when love, faith, and community come together. With your prayers and support, we are committed to shine Christ's light into the darkest corners of the world and transform lives, one family at a time.

OUR Collaborative Framework:

Collaboration is key to our mission. By working alongside families, local government, and partner organizations, we have expanded our impact throughout Uganda and the communities we serve. Through collaborative efforts, we trained parents and caregivers of children with disabilities and partnered to seek justice in a child defilement case. To enhance education accessibility, we collaborated with schools to welcome vulnerable children and received support from generous sponsors and donors, enabling us to shine Christ's light in our communities and throughout the world.
